Class 31 SSA – Open Equitation Class - Run under SSA Rules defined in the current Member's Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points. Southernden Farm offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. Side Saddle International offer a rosette to the Adult Member and Manor Grange Stud Show Centre to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out. Juniors must wear Hats to current Safety Standard or above.

Class 32 SSA – Classical Ladies Class - Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, P(UK) or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. NB Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by Mrs T Mitchell to the winner and if the winner has already qualified, a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only. The highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not exceed 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualifies for the current year's BSHA Championship Show The Broadband & Phones Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the next highest placed horse down to 5th place. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. SSA Members who qualify for The Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship.

Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors must wear hats to current Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

BSHA Affiliated Classes & RIHS Quals

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form. Classes 48-54 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

DAY TICKETS Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, **but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form, or apply online on the BSHA website.

Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme classes at the National Championship Show September 2018. (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

The Association will also award an Amateur Home Produced rosette in all Affiliated Open Cob classes (Light & Heavyweights only). These rosettes have been kindly sponsored by TSG, Mr L Turley. The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year.

SHB(GB) Affiliated Classes & RIHS Quals

This show is affiliated to the Sport Horse Breeding (GB) all entrants must be fully paid up members of the society and the horses need to be on the 2018 show horse registration all classes where affiliated to the SHB(GB) will be run under the society rules. All RIHS Qualifiers are for 2018.

Day Ticket = £35 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 show's in the year – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. **The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 30th August – 2nd September 2017. Shows held on or after the closing date of Championship Show will count as 2018 qualifiers.** The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers [Show Secretary to insert class numbers]. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. **All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.**

WINTER QUALIFIERS BOTH THE OWNER AND THE RIDER OF ANY EXHIBIT NEED NOT BE FULLY PAID-UP MEMBERS OF CHAPS (UK) AT THE TIME OF COMPETITION, NOR MUST THE ANIMAL BE REGISTERED; BUT TO VALIDATE THE QUALIFICATION, BOTH MEMBERSHIP AND REGISTRATION MUST BE IN PLACE WITH CHAPS (UK) AT THE TIME OF ENTERING THE RELEVANT YEARS' FINALS AND BOTH SECTIONS OF THE QUALIFIER CARD MUST BE RETURNED AS PER THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE CARD. MEMBERSHIP/REGISTRATION FROM CHAPS (UK) ADMIN, 1 MCLAREN COTTAGES, ABERTYSSWG, RHYMNEY, TREDEGAR NP22 5BH. ALL STALLIONS MUST BE GRADED WITH CHAPS (UK) IN ORDER TO COMPETE IN THESE CLASSES. Exhibits not to have qualified for HOYS in the current and previous year in which the Finals will be held (e.g. for 2017 Finals the horse or pony must not have qualified for HOYS in either 2015 or 2016). The 2 highest placed from each height/type category may qualify.

From the classes eight animals may qualify from the class placings:

- Non-Native Horse (exceeding 15hh) to be shown plaited and trimmed and to be ridden by the judge at the Final
- Non-Native Pony (15hh & under) to be shown plaited and trimmed and to perform an individual show at the Final
- Native/Traditional/Cob/Show Cob Type Horse (exceeding 14.2hh) to be shown either with full mane, tail and feather or hogged and trimmed as appropriate, to be ridden by the judge at the Final
- Native/Traditional/Cob/Show Cob Type Pony (14.2hh and under) to be shown either with full mane, tail and feather or hogged and trimmed as appropriate, to perform an individual show at the Final.

(Should four classes be held, each category as above must be complied with.)

The judges for the Qualifier Classes may be selected from the BSPS or CHAPS (UK) 'Approved Panel of Judges' and will be instructed NOT to ride any exhibit in the Qualifiers; these will be judged on conformation and individual show. At the Championships, which will be split into the four categories, the Ride & Conformation Judges will be selected from CHAPS (UK) 'Approved Panel Judges' and will be instructed to ride only the Non-Native Horse class and the Native/Traditional/Cob Horse class; the Non-Native Pony and the Native/Traditional/Cob Pony sections will perform individual shows only.

The Championship Finals will be held at the BSPS Winter Championship Show 2017, to be held 14th – 16th April and will comprise of:

- Non-Native Types 15.0hh and under
- Non-Native Type Horses exceeding 15.0hh
- Native/Traditional/Cob Types 14.2hh and under,
- Native/Traditional/Cob Types exceeding 14.2hh
- **The Finals will be held under the auspices of CHAPS (UK) Rules and Regulations.**

SSADL Affiliated Classes

All Olympia First Round Qualifiers are open to all riders/handlers and their ponies/horses. Six qualification cards will be given out in each class. If a competitor has already qualified then the qualification card will be handed down the line. Once you receive your qualification card and you are already affiliated and registered to SSAD Ltd. then you will have 10 days to send the card in. Follow the instructions on the card. If you are not affiliated or registered with SSAD Ltd. when you receive a qualification card then you will get 10 days to affiliate and register and send the card in. If this not done your qualification will not be valid. Go to www.seniorshowinganddressage.co.uk and click on Affiliations & Registrations.

BSPA Affiliated RIHS Classes

This show is affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association with qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead Tuesday 24th July 2018. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bsponline.com all horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands Exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate.

Competitors qualifying at this show for the Royal International Horse Show 24th-29th July 2018 must submit their entries by recorded delivery post within 48 hours of qualifying to The Showing Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU. Schedules and entry forms can be downloaded at <http://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/the-longines-royal-international-horse-show/>. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA showing permit (contact BSPA for Stallion showing permit information) for 2018 and have a BSPA stallion ID card and wear a BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.

No competitor/owner/horse may compete in classes 34-37 or enter the ring without current 2018 membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card.

Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. BSPA office 01354 638226 bspashows@gmail.com Skewbald & Piebald horses/ponies only. Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for Amateur and Junior Supreme Championship Finals to be held at BSPA World of colour Championship Show 2018 at the College EC, Keysoe, Bedfordshire. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed. All champion and reserve champion winners qualify for the BSPA Star Championship at WCC.

All horses/ponies must be registered with BSPA All Owners/riders members of BSPA prior to entry and membership + qualification cards must be carried into the ring and signed at the time of qualification in the ring by the Judge. Failure to comply with this rule will mean disqualification.
